## 3. Consent regarding the transfer of the rights of use of the recordings made for the abovementioned purpose

I hereby transfer the right to use the rights to the recording(s) from my person to KIT, without any restrictions in terms of time, space, and content. I agree that the recordings made may be used within the scope of the above-mentioned purpose.

If consent is not given to use and for use, the recording(s) will not be published. If consent is given, the recording(s) will be published only to the extent covered by your consent. Consent is voluntary and may be revoked in writing at any time. As far as the consent is not revoked, it is valid for an unlimited period of time. No disadvantages arise from the refusal of consent or your revocation.

The rights to the recording are granted without remuneration and also include the right to edit the recording (e.g. for better visibility) as long as the editing is not distorting.

\* **Note: Publication on the Internet:** If published on the Internet, the images can be accessed and stored worldwide, including in countries with a low level of data protection. They can therefore also be found via so-called "search engines". It cannot be ruled out that other persons or companies may link the images with other personal data available on the Internet, use them to create a personality profile, modify the images or use them for other purposes. In the event that consent is withdrawn, complete deletion of the recording and data from the Internet cannot be guaranteed.

## Important information on consent to the publication of personal data on the WEB

The consent of persons concerned to the publication of photos is one of the requirements that must be met (Section 22 of the German Art Copyright Act, right to one's own image) in order to be able to post photos on the Internet at all. However, this consent is linked to a procedure in which the persons concerned are comprehensively informed about the dangers of publication on the WEB and in which the following Internet risks must be explicitly mentioned:

- the possibility of national and international, thus worldwide, retrieval of the data posted on the WEB from the public and non-public spheres; the data stock advances to become a generally accessible source
- the right to informational self-determination of the data subjects is endangered if their data is published worldwide, i.e. also in countries where no or insufficient data protection standards exist, thus an appropriate level of data protection is not ensured
- the data posted can be read unnoticed and stored, changed, falsified, combined or manipulated in a variety of ways
- there is the possibility of a worldwide automated evaluation of the publication according to various search criteria, which can be linked with each other in any way (e.g. creation of a meaningful personality profile by combining information about the official position, the area of responsibility of the person concerned with data from a private context, selection among job applications, observation of persons)
- commercial use, e.g. risk of unsolicited letters and harassment
- by providing the data, there is naturally a waiver of the examination of the legitimate interest of the recipient in knowing the data
- if the data has been stored, the recipient may continue to use the data even if the party providing it has already changed or deleted its Internet offering.

The consent of the data subject must be obtained in writing and prior to publication.

### **2. Type and scope of data processing**

### **3. Legal basis of data processing (incl. possibility of revocation)**

The legal basis for the processing of your data is your consent pursuant to Article 6(1), first subparagraph, letter a DS-GVO. The consent is voluntary. If it is refused or revoked, no disadvantages will arise.

The revocation of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the processing carried out on the basis of the consent until the revocation. As far as the consent is not revoked, it is valid for an unlimited period of time.

#### **4. Storage period**

Your personal data will remain stored until the consent given for this purpose has been revoked, statutory retention obligations exist or they are archived in accordance with Article 5(1)(e) DS-GVO.

In the event of revocation, the corresponding recordings / the corresponding recording will no longer be used by HIU for the above-mentioned purposes in the future and will be deleted from the corresponding Internet offerings without delay. For publication in printed materials, a revocation after printing can only be taken into account in the next edition.

#### **5. Recipient**

In the case of publication on the Internet, the images can be accessed and stored worldwide, including in countries with a low level of data protection. They can therefore also be found via so-called "search engines". It cannot be ruled out that other persons or companies may link the images with other personal data available on the Internet, use them to create a personality profile, modify the images or use them for other purposes.

#### **6. Your rights**

You have the right to revoke your consent to the processing of your data in accordance with Article 7 (3) DS-GVO at any time with effect for the future. It can also refer to individual parts of the declaration. Furthermore, you have the following rights vis-à-vis us with regard to the personal data concerning you:

- Right to confirmation as to whether data relating to you is being processed and to information about the data processed, to further information about the data processing and to copies of the data (Article 15 DS-GVO).
- Right to have inaccurate or incomplete data corrected or completed (Article 16 DS-GVO).
- Right to erasure of data concerning you without delay (Article 17 DS-GVO)
- Right to restriction of processing (Article 18 DS-GVO)
- Right to object to future processing of data concerning you, where the data are processed pursuant to Article 6(1)(e) or (f) of the DS-GVO (Article 21 DS-GVO).

You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority about the processing of personal data concerning you by Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (KIT) (Article 77 DS-GVO). The
